36th Annual Screwball Regatta and Canadian Fireball National Championship

1. Organizing Authority

The regatta is organized by the Pointe Claire Yacht Club.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

3. Eligibility and Entry Fees

The regatta is open to members in good standing of a national Fireball Class Association recognized by Fireball International. All boats must comply with current class rules. At registration all entrants must present a valid measurement certificate and proof of class membership.

Entry fee: \$20.00

4. Registration

Registration will take place at Pointe Claire Yacht Club on Saturday, September 17 from 9h00 until 10h30. Payment can be made prior at registration.

5. Schedule

No warning signal will be made after 14h00 on Sunday.
A maximum of seven races are planned.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. Courses

The courses to be sailed will be triangle, windward, leeward courses.

8. Social

Wine and beer may be consumed after sailing. Dinner will not be provided, but

9. Accommodation

Camping is not allowed on club premises. Billeting will be made available upon request.

10. Measurement

During the event, random measurement checks may be made at the discretion of the class measurer.

11. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers and fun prizes will be awarded in keeping with the Screwball tradition. The prize giving will take place approximately 2 hours after the race committee arrives ashore on September 18.

12. Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
