

## The Peter Kelly Athlete Assistance Fund

Attention young sailors! The Peter Kelly Assistance Fund (PKAAF) was created at Pointe Claire Yacht Club to honour the memory of Peter Kelly by promoting youth sailing. Young sailors (25 and under) who are members of yacht clubs on Lac St. Louis should apply to help pay for their racing.

Peter Kelly was dedicated to young sailors. He created the first Optimist race team at PCYC by gathering some parents together to build a bunch of wooden Optimists. He cofounded the TRY (Training Regatta for Youth) at PCYC which became the biggest youth regatta in Quebec. He tirelessly advocated for youth sailing to the PCYC Executive. He was PCYC's Rear Commodore at the time of his untimely death in 2021. In Peter's spirit, the PKAAF raises funds to support young racers.

Thanks to generous donors the PKAAF will give money to young sailors to help pay for their regatta expenses. Applications should be delivered to the email found on our page before April 15, or June 15, August 15 and October 15. Applications not rewarded at one meeting will be reconsidered at the next. Receipts, especially for entry fees, will be required. Your application needs to include 3 regatta results and a paragraph describing why you should be rewarded. A video could enhance the application. The application form is here.

Le Fonds d'aide aux athlètes Peter Kelly

Avis aux jeunes marins! Le Fonds d'assistance Peter Kelly (PKAAF) a été créé au Yacht Club de Pointe Claire pour honorer la mémoire de Peter Kelly en faisant la promotion de la voile chez les jeunes. Les jeunes marins (25 ans et moins) qui sont membres de clubs nautiques sur le lac Saint-Louis devraient faire une demande pour aider à payer leurs courses.

Peter Kelly était dédié aux jeunes marins. Il a créé la première équipe de course Optimist au YCPC en rassemblant des parents pour construire un groupe d'Optimist en bois. Il a cofondé la TRY (Training Regatta for Youth) au YCPC qui est devenue la plus grande régate jeunesse au Québec. Il a défendu sans relâche la voile des jeunes auprès de l'exécutif du YCPC. Il était le contre-commodore du YCPC au moment de sa mort prématurée en 2021. Dans l'esprit de Peter, la PKAAF collecte des fonds pour soutenir les jeunes coureurs.

Grâce à de généreux donateurs, la PKAAF donnera de l'argent aux jeunes marins pour les aider à payer leurs frais de régate. Les candidatures doivent être envoyées à pcycoffice@pcyc.qc.ca avant le 15 avril, ou le 15 juin, le 15 août et le 15 octobre. Les candidatures non récompensées lors d'une réunion seront réexaminées lors de la suivante. Des reçus, notamment pour les frais d'inscription, seront exigés. Votre candidature doit inclure 3 résultats de régate et un paragraphe décrivant pourquoi vous devriez être récompensé. Une vidéo pourrait agrémenter l'application. ## Guidelines for the Peter Kelly Athlete Assistance Fund at Pointe Claire Yacht Club (PKAAF@PCYC)

- 1. The Peter Kelly Athlete Assistance Fund at Pointe Claire Yacht Club is the Corinthian Fund of PCYC for the support of young sailors. Funds are received both from PCYC members and via charitable donations to Wind Athletes Canada (WAC).
- 2. The PKAAF@PCYC will have an Advisory Committee consisting of a minimum of 3 members of PCYC elected by the PCYC Executive Board.
- 3. The Advisory Committee membership should consist of PCYC Members who are familiar with the activities of youth sailing programs.
- 4. Successful athlete candidates shall be selected by majority vote. Support is to be channeled towards sailors seriously endeavoring to improve and to excel at sailboat racing.
- 5. Money raised from the membership of Pointe Claire Yacht Club will only be used to support members of PCYC and full-time members of PCYC Youth Race Teams. Money raised from charitable donations to Wind Athletes may be used to support applicants from the sailing clubs on Lac St-Louis. Sailors will be supported who show merit and appropriate manner.
- 6. Permitted expenses shall include: 1. Regatta Fees 2. Travel (not including food and beverage) 3. Charter Boats 4. Coaching Fees 5. Part and sail purchases. All expenses must be evidenced by receipts.
- 7. a) Applicants must complete an application and provide evidence of payment of Regatta fees/event registration. b) Provide a reference from their coach, including the name and contact details (phone number, email) of the coach c) Provide a 100-word narrative on themselves and/or a short video of the candidate. A video shall not be mandatory but will enhance their application. d) Has demonstrated competence in the class of boat to be sailed in at the regatta for which assistance is being sought e) Provide a list of previous regattas, ranking, and number of competitors during the previous two-year period (if available) f) Athletes are required to be 25 years or younger to be eligible for support g) If selected, candidates shall use their best efforts to promote their support received by the Peter Kelly Athlete Assistance Fund by means such as submitting photos to official PKAAF social media.
- 8. The Committee shall convene once a year late in the summer or early fall to award funds to candidates. The Committee may institute a special appeal directed toward a specific purpose or applications that are time sensitive in nature.
- 9. The PKAFF expects to have the following caps on endorsements allocated to athletes on a per boat basis: 1. Local and National Events-\$2,000 (per annum, multiple applications and events permitted) 2. International Events-\$4,000 (per annum, multiple applications and events permitted. Exceptions are permitted.
- 10. Notwithstanding any of the above, the Peter Kelly Athlete Assistance Fund Committee shall have the final decision on the disposition of any application for assistance.
