SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



Saturday, September 27, 2025 Pointe-Claire Yacht Club, Lac St. Louis, Quebec

1. RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the Pas de Deux Event Page before 9:00am on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of the race will be posted by 8:00pm on the day before it will take effect.

3. COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted at 2025 Official Notice Board | PCYC

4. CODE OF CONDUCT

4.1 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag mast of the Race Committee boat docked at PCYC and an email will be sent to all registered participants.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 The class flag is a WHITE flag.

7. COURSES

- 7.1 Courses are described in Addendum A.
- 7.2 The Race Committee boat will display a numerical pennant indicating which course to be sailed.

8. MARKS

8.1 The marks that will be used are SLVYRA buoys.

9. THE START

- 9.1 The race will be started using RRS 26.
- 9.2 The Preparatory Signal will be the "I" (India) flag using RRS 30.1.
- 9.3 The starting line will be between the orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the course side of the port end starting mark (SLVYRA buoy 32).
- 9.4 Boats must start according to their assigned starting times on the Start Times List. This list will be posted on the Pas de Deux event page.
- 9.5 A boat that does not start within five minutes after her assigned starting time will be scored DNS (Did Not Start) without a hearing and will receive a score of zero points. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

10. THE FINISH

10.1 The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the Race Committee boat and the course side of the starboard end finishing mark (SLVYRA buoy 32).

11. TIME LIMITS

- 11.1 The Finishing Window, which is the time limit for boats to finish after the first boat sails the course and finishes, will be 45 minutes.
- 11.2 Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window shall be scored DNF (Did Not Finish) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1 and A5.2.
- 11.3 A boat scored DNF will receive a score of zero. This changes RRS A5.2.

12. HEARING REQUESTS

- 12.1 To file a protest, a Hearing Request form must be submitted to the address indicated on the form by 8:00pm on the day of
- 12.2 Hearing request forms are on the Pas de Deux Race event page.
- 12.3 RRS 61.2(b)(2) and 63.7(b) do not apply.
